Who is George Stevens? That is a hard question to answer because he was so many things to so many people. Most importantly he was a cherished son, brother, husband, father, uncle and friend. He was also a musician and an educator.

George was the Orchestra Director at Newington High School when he was diagnosed with Leukemia in 2006. A shocked community banded together and stood beside George and his family during an eight month battle that took his life.

His passion for music and education needed to be honored and celebrated for generations to come so the George F. Stevens Scholarship Fund was established and funded by his family in 2007. In 2011, his family established the George F. Stevens Education Fund, an endowed scholarship fund at the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving. The scholarship is awarded annually to a senior at Newington High School who is pursuing a degree in music and/or education.

George would start his practice sessions by telling his students "You are my inspiration," words we can all live by now when we remember this great man who we loved so dearly and miss every day. Thank you for honoring George's memory and for providing hope to a student who may someday pass on George's passion for music and education and bring inspiration to future generations.

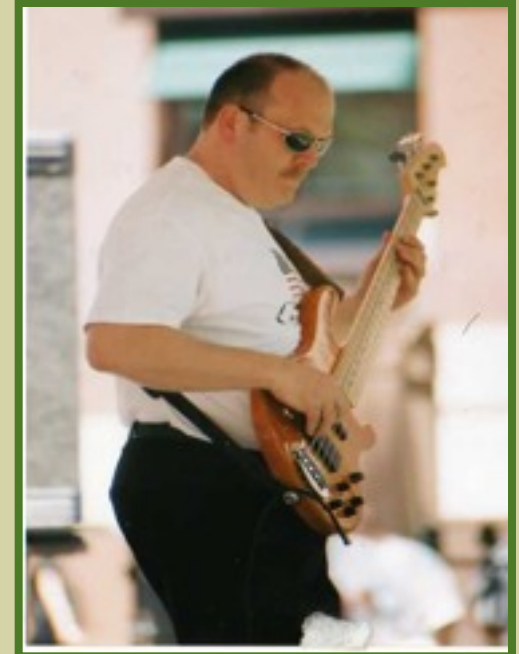
